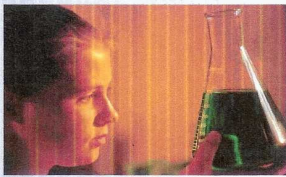


Elementary and Junior High Homeschooling

This brochure is meant to help homeschool educators meet the standards for educating their student.

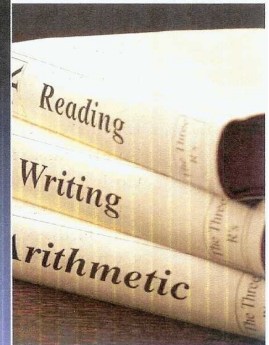
Homeschooling curriculum is available for elementary and junior high students.
